The Employment & Training Corporation (ETC) can help you.

How?

1. **ETC daily Automailer** – Start receiving an e-mail with information on the most recent vacancies (*full-time, part-time, summer jobs*). Just send an e-mail to vacancy.etc@gov.mt instructing us to add you.

2. **Registering on part 3B** of the ETC register – If you are a student, you can register with the Corporation on Part 3B.

All you have to do is send an e-mail to records.etc@gov.mt requesting to register on Part 3B. Also include:

- a) A list of jobs you are interested in
- b) Your CV
- c) Copies of any relevant certificates
- d) The National Insurance Card (N.I. which you can obtain from any branch office of the Department of Social Security)

You will then start receiving information on summer jobs by post.

Alternatively you can go to one of our Job Centers and register there.
Remember to take your ID card, CV, N.I. number and any relevant certificates!
